

FSCB MEMBERSHIP LEVELS AND REQUIREMENTS

Junior Club: Junior Club is a program designed to make the transition from Skate School to the club an easy step. Junior Club is part of the FSCB. Junior Club skaters meet weekly with a FSCB Home Club coach of their choice for a private lesson. Junior Club skaters can also buy into additional club ice time if they would like to skate more than once a week. Junior Club membership is valid for one calendar year from the point of registration. Volunteering and fundraising for FSCB is encouraged, but not required.

Introductory: Introductory members have completed one calendar year as a Junior Club member, but are not yet ready to move to a full Home Club membership. Introductory members are eligible for one year as an Introductory member before moving into a Home Club membership. This membership level allows a skater to work toward their skating goals with a home club coach, via private lessons. Introductory members must contract 1 session per contract and have outstanding invoices paid to remain a Member-In-Good-Standing. Volunteer and fundraising requirements are to be completed from July 1 to June 30. Volunteer requirement is 4 hours, with 2 of the 4 volunteer hours served at the Skate Bloomington competition in April. Fundraising requirement is \$50.

Home Club Member: This level of membership allows a skater to work toward their skating goals with a home club coach, via private lessons. It is the next step up in a skater's progression after the Junior Club or for skater transferring from another club. Home Club members must contract at least two sessions per contract and have outstanding invoices paid to remain a Member-in-Good-Standing. Volunteer and fundraising requirements are to be completed from July 1 to June 30. The volunteer requirement is 16 hours, with 6 of the 16 volunteer hours served at the Skate Bloomington competition in April. The fundraising requirement is \$150 for Preliminary and Below Free Skate level and \$300 for Pre-Juvenile to Senior Free Skate level. Families with 2 or more skaters will be responsible for \$100 for each additional skater.

Collegiate for members that are over 18 years in age and enrolled in school full time. Volunteering and fundraising for FSCB is encouraged, but not required.

Adult any member over 18 years in age and not enrolled in school full time. Volunteering and fundraising for FSCB is encouraged, but not required.

Northernettes Associate Member: This membership is reserved only for skaters with a home club membership elsewhere and who skate with one of the Northernettes competition synchronized skating teams. This associate membership cannot be used by a home club member of the Figure Skating Club of Bloomington, nor in lieu of a standard associate membership. This membership type requires a home club membership and cannot be used individually as a membership with USFS.

Associate Member: Many skaters from other clubs become Associate Members to use the FSCB as their primary training center in the summer or during the year to train on club ice. Associate memberships are offered for skaters whose home club is other than FSCB.
